Conditions of admission:

As soon as it becomes available, please submit a final copy of your high school transcript showing the date of your graduation or diploma. If you elected for your SAT/ACT scores to be considered in the admission process, and have not yet requested your test scores be sent to USC from the testing agency, please do so immediately. You will not be permitted to begin classes at USC beyond your first semester without these items.

Enrollment Commitment:
To reserve your place in the class and enable you to register at USC, you must complete the Reply Form by May 1, 2021. A \$300 nonrefundable deposit (applicable toward tuition) or valid waiver request will be required. You can accept or decline our offer of admission online at admission.usc.edu/status.
